Her research both into the extended family and the families of others, lead to her recognition by the North Carolina Genealogical Society when she received the 2003 Award for Outstanding Contribution to the Society as a Member. She helped start their scholarship fund which helps women who want to return to continue their education. Her interests and activities included gardening, sewing, bird watching, and piano. Her favorite vacation spots were the beaches of North Carolina and the Gulf Coast of Florida.
