FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT MEMBERSHIP

Q. If I am not a member of St. Paul's, can I participate in the sacrament of the Eucharist (Communion)?

A. All baptized Christians are invited to participate in receiving the Holy Eucharist. Everyone is welcome to come forward and receive a blessing.

Q. If I attend St. Paul's, am I considered a "member" for [preschool registration](#)?

A. You are considered a member if you have been contributing your time, talent or treasure to St. Paul's by December 1 prior to the year of enrollment. Making a financial contribution, taking part in one of the ministries of St. Paul's, completing a pledge card, teaching Sunday School, or serving on a committee are all considered contributions.

Q. Do you have a parish directory? How can I be included?

A. We have a printed directory of names and addresses which we update yearly. Those who register their names and addresses with the church office are included, unless they opt out. Contact us at 919-467-1477 or at stpauls@stpaulscary.org if you have questions about the directory.

Q. Why should I transfer my membership here from another church?

A. It is helpful to have the church you are now attending keep track of your household's sacramental records (baptism, confirmation, marriage). Many churches forward these records as people move from place to place. We are happy to work with your former church if you are interested in officially transferring your membership.
