Pre-EYC (Episcopal Youth Community) is a fun fellowship program for 4th and 5th graders. We plan to gather twice each month, usually on Sundays, for fun, food, and outreach activities. Pre-EYC will meet from September through May.

The main goal of Pre-EYC is to build a church community for 4th and 5th graders. We will interact and build friendships within the context of a loving spiritual network. The emphasis of Pre-EYC will be engaging children in fun activities so that they may develop a strong peer group. We believe this serves as an important bridge between St. Paul's offerings for younger children and older youth. While classmates and schools may change, it is our hope that church friends will remain constant through middle and high school.

Pre-EYC will have two types of meetings each month. The first will be a fellowship gathering with opportunities to eat meals together, learn, and play. The second will be an outreach activity.
