## **Helpful Tips:**

- If you are picking up live or cooked lobsters to go, we highly recommend that you **bring a cooler** to put them in. We will pack the lobsters in *mostly* waterproof bags, but a cooler will provide an extra level of security. Your car will thank you.
- If you are picking up live lobsters, we recommend a layer of ice in the bottom of your cooler to keep the lobsters fresh until you are ready to cook them. Do not use dry ice! Dry ice melts into carbon dioxide which will kill the lobsters.

- When you arrive at the church, please park where our Hosts direct you and proceed to the large white **Guest Check-in Tent** in front of our Parish Hall building. (Please let a Host know if you need handicap parking or special assistance.)
- As you proceed through the check-in, you will verify your order and receive a colored chip for each item you have ordered.
- At that point you will be directed either to the Outside Lobster Cooking & Distribution
  Tent for pick-up of your live / cooked lobsters, or inside the Parish Hall for pick-up / eat-in of your Meals and/or Lobster Rolls.
- We will have both Indoor and Courtyard (outside, under a tent) seating available.
- There will be many Hosts/Volunteers around the campus wearing name tags. Please ask any of them if you have a question or need any kind of assistance.
- If you have forgotten to place your order, there is still time! You may place orders until Oct 1 via the Lobster Fest website.
- We have ordered extra lobsters and lobster rolls to sell on a first-come-first-served basis, so please let your friends know that they can make walk-up purchases at the event. Invite them to join you for a treat and support a good cause. You can't do much better than that!

Our goal is that you have a wonderful experience. Please let us know if you need any assistance at all.
