

St. Paul's is committed to being responsible stewards of our budget and financial contributions, ensuring that we maximize the good we can create together with our gifts. We achieve strong fiscal management through the following structure.

<u>Vestry</u>. The Vestry is the elected lay leadership of the parish, serving as trustees in charge of secular concerns. The Vestry establishes the budget, and authorizes officers, ministry leaders, staff and clergy in the management and use of parish resources.

Finance Committee. Monitors and reports on the financial health of the parish during the year, makes recommendations to the vestry on financial items that could improve its financial health, and prepares the annual budget and year-end statement for the vestry's approval.

<u>Endowment Board</u>. Manages the St. Paul's Endowment Fund and disbursement of the Endowment's investment income. The Board also facilitates educational opportunities for planned giving and serves as a contact point for parishioners interested in planned giving.

Annual Stewardship Campaign Committee. The Stewardship Committee encourages donors to view themselves as stewards of the gifts that God has provided, and to freely and selflessly give of those gifts to further St. Paul's mission and the work of Christ through our ministries.
