

Refuge for Refugees Ministries | A St. Nicholas Ministry Partner

Refuge for Refugees (R4R) began as a St. Paul's ministry in 2016 to assist families granted refugee status as they resettle in our local community. R4R members provide ongoing friendship and support to families as they adjust to life in their new homes. In 2023, St. Paul's provided gifts for 16 R4R children ages 0-17.



R4R works with the US Committee for Refugees and Immigrants-North Carolina (USCRI-NC). St. Paul's has supported as co-sponsor (with USCRI) families and individuals from El Salvador, Afghanistan, Syria, Ethiopia, Somalia, and Burma. St. Paul's has provided support to more than 12 refugee family groups since the ministry began in 2016, over 70 individuals!
